Banded Stator Work

The Shop Committee and Senior Management have been meeting on the new Banded Stator work that will be coming to Indianapolis.

Indianapolis will become the global site for Banded Stators. We will be getting the Trent 1000 and XWB Banded Stators work. The company has also agreed to in-source the production work for the AE Banded Stators that are currently being done by an outside supplier. At this time, a decision has not been made where Banded Stators site will be located. New machinery has been ordered.

The Banded Stators site has the potential to grow to approximately 80 people by 2017.

Health Care Transition

The health care transition is progressing very smoothly. We have transitioned approximately 700 members at this time.
