Safety Shoe Update

The safety shoe mobile will be on-sight starting first thing Thursday morning, July 1 at Plant #8 and at Plant #5. The exact location is yet to be determined. The shoe mobile is scheduled to be here as follows:

Plant 8

July 1,2,7,8,15,20,21,29

Hours: 5:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Plant 5

July 1,2,7,8,13,14,22,27,28

SCO

July 7 - 6-9 a.m. and 1-4 p.m.

Focus Factory

July 7 - 7:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

There will be at least 23 brand names of shoes with around 140 styles to choose from on the shoe mobile and/or in the store. All shoes and/or boots comply with the "ASTM" standards and are safety toe. This does not necessarily mean steel toed, but could be composite, aluminum, titanium, or some other safety material as long as it meets the ASTM requirements. All electricians and anyone that must comply with the 70E/electrical hazards must get the appropriate protective footwear.

Payment for the safety footwear will be covered in full up to \$100.00 with showing your badge and your 7 digit I.D number (located on the back of your badge). There will be "**NO**" payroll deduct for amounts over \$100.00, but the shoe mobile will take credit cards.

If anyone has orthotic devices or diabetes, let the workers from Footwork's know your issues.
