## COLA

In accordance with the UAW Rolls-Royce Co0llective Bargaining Agreement (Cost-of-Living Allowance), the cost-of-living is based on the three-month average of the U.S. only CPI-W as follows:

April 2009	201.112
March 2009	200.421
February 2009	199.928
<b>Three-month Average</b>	<b>200.49</b>

The above index figures result in an increase in the cost-of-living of ten cents (\$0.10) per hour. The adjustment will be effective the first pay period beginning June 1, 2009. This bring the COLA total to \$2.2550.
