H.O.S.T.S. MENTOR OPPORTUNITIES

Wayne Township School System is in need of H.O.S.T.S. Mentors (Helping One Student To Succeed). Mentors volunteer once a week for one hour to visit the school and work with two children, at the second grade level, to improve their reading and vocabulary skills. A typical student in the program will improve two grade levels due to the one-on-one study with an adult Mentor.

Our Local Union, along with the Rolls-Royce Leadership, believes this to be an important, and worthwhile, community involvement program. To expand our involvement we would like to give the opportunity for participation to our UAW members. Employees would mentor during the prescribed period, depending upon the Wayne Township School to which they are assigned. Your time participating in this program will be paid as if you were working on your job. Of course, we cannot adversely affect the operation of the business so participation will be limited. This nationally recognized program not only benefits the child, but will also be very rewarding for you, as well as our Union and Rolls-Royce.

Although our full participation will not start until the beginning of the new school year in the fall of 2004, we would like to begin recruiting volunteers at this time. Over the next few weeks we plan on giving interested individuals the opportunity to go to the schools and see how a mentoring session works. Hopefully, this will help you determine if this is something you would like to be involved in. Additionally, we will be holding four, short, informational sessions in the Training Center to explain the program and to answer any questions.
