In accordance with the UAW/Rolls-Royce Collective Bargaining Agreement (Cost-of-Living Allowance), the cost-of-living is based on the three-month average.

Three month average 553.0

The above index figures results in an increase in cost-of-living of seven cents (.07¢) per hour. The adjustment will be effective beginning on December 6, 2004. This brings the COLA total to \$1.07 per hour.
