COLA

In accordance with the UAW/Rolls-Royce Collective Bargaining Agreement (Cost-of-Living Allowance) the Cost-of-Living is based on the three-month average of the U.S. only CPI-W as follows:

April 2006	-	191.3
March 2006	-	189.5
February 2006	-	188.4
Three Month Average	-	189.73

The above index figures result in an increase in Cost-of-Living of twenty-seven (.27 ¢) per hour. The COLA agreement provides for a diversion of \$.075, resulting in an increase of \$.2525. The adjustment will be effective June 5, 2006. This brings the COLA total to \$1.1625 per hour.

APPRENTICESHIP TEST

We had 29 members take the Apprenticeship Test on Saturday, May 13, 2006. Hopefully we will have the results in about 60 days.

NEW HIRE PROCEDURE

Many questions have been asked about applying for job openings at Rolls-Royce in the Bargaining Unit. Management will establish the application procedure on line no later than June 1, 2006. When that information is available we will communicate this to you in this form.

ENHANCED RETIREMENT AND VTEP

As of today May 23, 2006, we have 15 Skilled Trades members and 11 Production members apply for the Retirement Program and 1 member VTEP. The open window for retirement is open until May 31st and VTEP will run until June 12, 2006.
