"There will be a bid sale for all golf carts, scooters, and bicycles beginning Monday, June 26<sup>th</sup> at 12:00 p.m. (daylight savings time) through Monday, July 3<sup>rd</sup> at 3:00 p.m. (daylight savings time). Management will accept one bid per person and you will not be given the opportunity to increase your bid. The highest bidder on each lot, will be awarded the lot. All bids are to be submitted to LeeAnn Chambers by Monday, July 3<sup>rd</sup> at 3:00 p.m. (daylight savings time). Please include your name and a phone number you can be reached when submitting your bid.

There will be six lots of (1) golf cart, (2) scooters, and (2) bicycles, two lots of (5) scooters, and two lots of (5) bicycles. There will be one day for inspection on June 29<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 a.m. – 9:30 a.m., and 3:15 – 4:30 p.m. (daylight savings time). There will be no test drives allowed. All units were running when turned in. Buyers will be responsible for loading their own units and must schedule their pick ups with LeeAnn Chambers. All sales are final and are sold "as is, where is". Items must be paid for prior to pick up via cash or money order. If paying by money order, please make payable to Quality Mill Supply company. There will be .06% sales tax added to all orders unless you provide a valid Indiana Sales Tax Exemption certificate or number, in which case you will be asked to fill out a form (which will be provided). Pick up times will be as follows and will need to be scheduled with LeeAnn Chambers.

Friday, July 14<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 a.m. – 9:30 a.m. (afternoon and midnight shifts)

Friday, July 14<sup>th</sup> from 3:15 p.m. – 4:30 p.m. (day and midnight shifts)

### **Tuition Assistance Reimbursement Guidelines**

The UAW/Rolls-Royce Tuition Assistance Plan (Doc. No.8) provides for tuition and/or compulsory fees to be paid directly to the schools providing the course in which the applicants are enrolled. The employee must submit a completed TAP form to the Tuition Assistance office for approval. Once it has been approved a voucher is issued to the student to pay the tuition and/or fees.

Occasionally, there are some vendors who will not accept vouchers and require payment up front before you begin the class. If you have to pay the class yourself we want to caution you to make sure that the Course/School has been pre-approved by the UAW/Rolls-Royce TAP office before paying. Schools/Courses have to meet certain eligibility requirements to be considered for TAP payment. **Please make sure you submit a TAP form to the Tuition Assistance office and have it pre-approved before paying monies out to any school.**

**Enhanced Retirement**- As of 6-26-06, 11 skilled tradesmen and 11 production employees have exercised their right under the 2005 agreement to retire effective 7-1-06 with the 5 year credited service enhancement. Congratulations to all these members. In addition, 4 employees have taken the VTEP. The 5 year credited service program will continue through the end of the month.
