## COLA

In accordance with the UAW/Rolls-Royce Collective Bargaining Agreement (Cost of Living Allowance), the Cost-of-Living is based on the three-month average of the U.S. only CPI-W as follows:

July 2006	193.2
June 2006	192.8
May 2006	192.4
Three month average	192.8

The above index figures result in an increase in the Cost-of-Living of thirty-eight (\$.38) per hour. The COLA agreement provides for a diversion of \$.075, resulting in an increase of \$.3625. The adjustment will be effective September 4, 2006. This brings the COLA total to \$1.5250 per hour.

## SMOKING CESSATION

In an effort to help employees who want to take this opportunity to quit smoking and/or using tobacco products of any kind, UAW Local 933 and Rolls-Royce have teamed with Clarian Health to provide a smoking/tobacco Cessation Program free of charge to all Rolls-Royce Indianapolis employees. This program is six (6) weeks long. You will meet with a trained professional one (1) hour per week. Classes will be half hour Company paid time and half hour unpaid.
