The change in the index average is sufficient to increase the Cost-Of-Living Allowance for the next quarter. Accordingly, in line with the current General Motors wage adjustment formula, hourly-rate employees will receive an increase of five cents (5¢) per hour in the Cost-of-Living Allowance for hours worked on or after December 6, 2004.

Thereafter, until further notice, the Cost-of-Living Allowance will be sixty-seven cents (67¢) per hour.
