RESULTS OF NATIONAL RATIFICATION VOTE

The following is the official notification Local 933 received from the International Union on the outcome of the vote on Health Care and National Agreement changes.

UAW President Ron Gettelfinger and Vice President Richard Shoemaker who directs the UAW General Motors Department, announced on 11/11/05 that UAW members ratified the Tentative Agreement with GM on health care by a 61 percent majority.

Voting was conducted at UAW-GM Local Unions throughout the United States from November 2nd to November 10th.

The proposed changes to retiree health care benefits in the Tentative Agreement are subject to approval by the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan.
