## **RESOLUTIONS FOR UAW/GM NATIONAL NEGOTIATIONS AND THE 34<sup>th</sup> UAW CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION**

In preparation for 2007 National Negotiations between UAW/GM, the Speedway Shop Committee is calling for YOUR resolutions (**proposed changes**) pertaining to UAW Constitutional matters and/or National Agreement negotiated language. **They may be turned in to your elected representative or dropped off at the in-plant Union Work Center (Bay C-31). UAW Local 933 Union Hall will also serve as a collection point for resolutions. Deadline for submittal is Friday, March 31, 2006.**

The process for approving resolutions relating to UAW policy or the UAW Constitution itself concludes at the 34<sup>th</sup> *UAW Constitutional Convention* held in Las Vegas, NV. (June 2006). Other proceedings at this Convention include the election of International Union officers and Regional Directors. Resolutions relating to **National Agreement issues** should represent specific needs of UAW-GM members and their families as provided by our Collective Bargaining Agreement. (e.g. Pension, Health Care Benefits, etc.) Once they are processed through several procedural steps (see below), they are finally voted upon at the *UAW Special Convention* attended by UAW (GM) delegates in early 2007. It is **extremely** important that Members submit resolutions. Ultimately, they help define how we function as a Union as well as determine the UAW's bargaining position for the upcoming 2007 National negotiations with GM. The following information briefly outlines the procedure used to process YOUR resolutions:

- The Shop Committee will review all submitted resolutions and index them according to the appropriate Paragraph #, Document #, etc.
- The Membership must then convene to review/discuss/vote on the resolutions. This session will take place at our Union Hall during a special unit meeting (**tentatively planned for late April 2006**)
- All approved resolutions must then be submitted to the appropriate UAW/GM Sub Councils for a review and vote
- The UAW/GM department of the International Union and the National Negotiating Committee (NNC) will review and combine the resolutions submitted by the different UAW/GM Sub Councils
- The UAW/GM Department and the NNC will then present the resolutions at the Special Collective Bargaining Convention for approval
- A UAW National GM Council meeting (consisting of all UAW/GM Chairmen and Presidents) will be held at which time the NNC will present the proposed resolutions to the Council for final approval
- The resolutions will be presented to General Motors during National Negotiations.
