C.O.L.A. (Cost of Living Allowance)

The three-month average of CPIW for May, June, and July 2006 is 192.8 resulting in a C.O.L.A. increase of \$0.38 (thirty-eight cents) per hour. There is a \$0.08 (eight cents) diversion from the September C.O.L.A. of which \$0.06 (six cents) being allocated to the retiree health care (VEBA) **leaving a total increase of \$0.30 (thirty cents).**

The \$0.30(thirty cents) C.O.L.A. increase for May, June and July 2006 is to be added to the present \$1.68 **bringing the total C.O.L.A. to \$1.98 per hour effective September 4, 2006.**
