Please return this form to your elected representative or place it in the drop box located at the in-plant Union Work Center (Bay C-31). Deadline for submission is Friday, November 10, 2006. NOTE: All bargaining related resolutions submitted by Speedway Unit Members earlier this year (March 31, 2006) are being held and remain active and should **NOT** be resubmitted. **Only NEW or additional resolutions are necessary!****

Remember, your new/additional resolution(s) must be bargaining related pertaining to Nationally negotiated issues such as Job/income security, healthcare benefits, pensions, outsourcing, subcontracting, health & safety, etc. ALL Speedway Unit bargaining resolutions will be read/discussed/heard during the month of December at the Local 933 Union Hall. At this time, a date and time has not been determined. As soon as a date is confirmed, it will be communicated to the Membership in an upcoming Speedway Chairman's Report (Update).

For your information, our Speedway Unit Constitutionally related resolutions were read/discussed at the April 2006 Local Membership Meeting. Thereafter, they were processed according to UAW procedure and addressed during the June 2006 Constitutional Convention.
