2007 LOCAL NEGOTIATIONS (Demands)

As you know, our 2003 Local Agreement between UAW Local 933 and Allison Transmission will expire in September 2007. While an exact date has not been determined at this time, 2007 Local Negotiations are expected to commence shortly after the July 4th shutdown. In preparation, the Shop Committee is now calling for **Local Demands that should be submitted***using the back of this form.***** **Deadline for submitting Demands is 11:59 pm on April 30, 2007.** Keep in mind, Local Demands may be related to Transfer, Shift Preference, and other Local Seniority Agreement matters as well as working conditions, etc. Health care, pension, general wage issues are National Agreement items. Please return your completed forms to any elected Bargaining Representative or at the UAW Work Center.

INSOURCING

The Local 933 Speedway Unit (Appendix L, National Agreement) Sourcing Committee (Rich Bales, Gary Hicks, Tim Snyder, Keith Surber) is pleased to announce the insourcing of four (4) X-200 parts (3 carriers & 1 piston) that will soon be fabricated from **rough cut to finish** operations using Local 933 (Plant 14) labor. These X-200 parts will also create additional work for the Tool Room (fixtures, tooling). A total of 7 new parts have been brought in-house within the past 9 months including three (3) Power Takeoff Unit (PTU) parts (**rough – finish**). **Did you know, of the 230 parts currently made in-house throughout the entire division, 223 are completely fabricated from rough to finish.**

*****REQUISITIONS FOR ADDITIONAL MANPOWER*****

As of Thursday afternoon (3-15-07), Allison Transmission submitted **50 requisitions** to the National Employment Placement Center (NEPC) for additional manpower. At this time, the specific arrival date(s) for these new Local 933 Members is yet to be determined by the NEPC. However, they are expected to arrive in multiple groups beginning (approx.) in mid April 2007 through early Summer. Upon their arrival, they will attend the three-week new employee orientation classes and will be placed in areas/departments determined to be most critical to our operations.
