ALLISON POTENTIAL SALE (Progress Report)

According to Local Management, the GM Treasury Department has indicated the bidding process has been narrowed to two (2) candidates as potential buyers of Allison Transmission. The two parties have not been identified/announced by name. Should the remaining bidding process identify a single bidder as the potential new owner, I will immediately inform the Membership as soon as reliable/factual information is communicated to me through the proper parties. As a reminder, a final sale approval will require Governmental review/acceptance as well as a Memorandum of Understanding between the International Union, UAW, and General Motors. Thank you for your continued patience/understanding in this matter.

INDEPENDENCE WEEK/VACATION WEEK (Pay Procedure)

Due to the Independence week shutdown, all hourly payroll checks will be mailed to your address of record for week ending July 1, 2007. Payroll checks for week ending July 8, 2007 will be distributed in the usual and customary manner. If you are scheduled to work the 2nd week (vacation week), payroll checks for week ending July 8th will be available through your Supervisor. Otherwise, those not working the 2nd week will have their checks mailed for week ending July 8th...or they may be picked up in the Mail Room (basement of Plt. 3 Administration Building) on Friday, July 13th between the hours of 8:30 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. (midnight & afternoon shift) AND 1:00 p.m. – 3:30 p.m. (ALL SHIFTS). Any overtime worked during these two payroll periods will be paid in the usual and customary manner and will be included on the appropriate payroll draft. Note: Members scheduled to work during the Independence Week Shutdown and who are credited with “additional time-off” (ATO) will be able to schedule that time in accordance with local practice.

For those Members looking to get a head start on the upcoming Independence Week Shutdown, the procedure for an early paycheck release requires you obtain/complete an “early paycheck release” form (available from your Supervisor). The completed form must be received in the Mail Room no later than the end of normal day shift business hours on Wednesday's. Your check will then be available for pick-up (mail room) on Thursday's after 2:30 p.m. Note: This does not apply for payroll checks for week ending July 1, 2007 as these checks are mailed.

As such, they will be included in the upcoming Local Negotiations; among other responsibilities outlined in the National Agreement.
