UAW-GM MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING **(Informational Meetings)**

The International Union is in the process of preparing Highlights of the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) covering Local 933 Speedway Bargaining Unit Members in the event of a FINAL SALE of Allison Transmission. MOU Highlights will be available to the Local Union and hand delivered to the Membership at the plant entrances on Monday, July 30, 2007.

On Tuesday morning (July 31, 2007), representatives of the International Union, UAW will meet with the Local Shop Committee to explain the MOU. Thereafter, Informational Meetings will be held for Members of Local 933 where the entire MOU will be distributed. Meetings will be conducted by representatives of the International Union involved in negotiating the MOU and will take place at the Local 933 Union Hall according to the following schedule.
