## **ALLISON TRANSMISSION**

### **(Final Sale Announcement)**

Yesterday afternoon, local management reported that General Motors has completed the sale of Allison Transmission to the Carlyle Group and Onex Corporation effective August 7, 2007. According to the announcement, we are to be known as Allison Transmission, Inc. Representatives of the International Union, UAW, have been informed of the final sale closing.

## **2003 LOCAL AGREEMENT EXTENSION**

The 2003 Collective Bargaining Agreement between Allison Transmission and UAW Local 933 has been extended with the mutual agreement of the National parties. The extension is to be in place until a 2007 Agreement can be reached between UAW and GM. Therefore, Local Negotiations have been temporarily suspended and will resume at a later date that coincides with a National settlement.
