### **2007 UAW-GM TENTATIVE**

### **AGREEMENT REACHED**

As most already know, the UAW and General Motors have reached a Tentative 2007 Collective Bargaining Agreement sending thousands of striking UAW members back to work. UAW (GM) Presidents and Bargaining Chairmen are in Detroit, MI. to meet with International Union Representatives for an explanation of the tentative pact and to finalize and release details/timelines for conducting special rank and file Membership Explanation/Ratification Meetings. International Union, UAW Representatives will meet with Local Union Shop Committee Members, District Committeepersons, and Internationally Appointed Representatives to explain the Tentative Agreement in Chicago, IL. on Saturday, September 29<sup>th</sup>.

Upon my return from Detroit, I will immediately update the Local 933 Speedway Membership with scheduled dates/times for Explanation Meetings conducted by International Union officials at our Union Hall. I fully anticipate the entire written 2007 contract proposal will be distributed for Membership review at the meetings(s).
