## CHRISTMAS HOLIDAY SHUTDOWN (Pay Procedure)

Payroll (check deposits) for the upcoming Christmas Holiday period will be handled in the usual and customary manner. Deposits for week ending 12/20/09 will be made on 12/24/09. Deposits for week ending 12/27/09 will be made on 12/31/09. Employees working during the Holiday period who choose the Deferred Holiday Option must fill out the required "deferral form" (see Supervisor for appropriate form) and submit to the payroll Department no later than Friday of the week in which the Holiday falls.

The basic qualifying rule to be eligible for full Holiday Pay during the Christmas period is the employee must work the last scheduled work day prior to the holiday period and the next scheduled work day after each holiday period. See Para. 203 (3) (a) of the Master Collective Bargaining Agreement.

## DEPENDENT SCHOLARSHIP TUITION ASSISTANCE, LEGAL SERVICES, CLOTHING STORE

As a reminder, beginning January 1, 2010, Scholarships for Dependent Children, Tuition Assistance, and Legal Services negotiated programs will once again be in full force following the brief deferral period.

**NOTE:** As recently reported, the UAW/Allison **Clothing Store** is once again open for business (see store hours in Speedway Chairman's Report (#437)). According to store personnel, the shelves are fully stocked at this time.
