### **UAW / GM CONTRACT TALKS**

As you may have learned over the past weekend, the UAW and General Motors have a new tentative collective bargaining agreement as a result of negotiations between the parties. Details of the agreement have not been released until an explanation meeting can be held with UAW/GM Local Union officials/representatives.

Clearly, many members of UAW Local 933 have an interest in gaining information about the tentative UAW/GM agreement. To this end, the Speedway Shop Committee and elected representatives will circulate reliable written material (highlights) throughout the plants as soon as it becomes available. However, we can only speculate as to the details as Local 933 representatives are not scheduled/approved to attend the national explanation meeting given we are no longer part of UAW/GM structure.
